The Helicopter Museum

The world's largest helicopter museum, with over eighty displayed aircraft, interactive zone and film theatre. You will see the Queen's Royal Flight, Bell UH-1H 'Huey', The Helicopter World Speed Record Holder, Autogyros, Russian Hind Gunship and Search and Rescue Helicopters. Dogs are welcome.

Revo Neon Golf

The Stable Games Room

Puxton Park

Set within 40 acres of beautiful Somerset countryside, Puxton Park is an all-weather attraction with aerial climbing to the fast and furious slides, there is something for everyone including an indoor adventure play zone with loads of fun features and a dedicated toddler area.

Noah's Ark Zoo Farm

Run wild in 100 acres of stunning Somerset countryside at Noah's Ark Zoo Farm. With 12 indoor and outdoor adventure play areas suitable for all ages. About a 45 minute drive from Weston and very close to Tyntesfield, a National Trust property.

Hutton Moor Leisure Centre

Located on the A370 about a mile from the centre of Weston-super-Mare, next to the Premier Inn and the skateboard park, Hutton Moor offers a 25m swimming pool, teaching pool, squash and tennis courts, treatment room and onsite café. Your family can spend a happy few hours out of the rain.



Wookey Hole

Spectacular caves and legendary home of the Witch of Wookey. The Wookey Hole Caves are the perfect break for fun and adventure in the rain. About an hour's drive from Weston, not easily accessed by bus.

Cheddar Caves

Get ready to explore the mysterious chambers of a cave that's over 500,000 years old! Duck into secret caverns, see the ancient elders' meeting chamber, and prepare to be amazed at the incredible vistas created by stalagmites and stalactites. About a 35 minute drive from Weston.
