### The Grand Pier

From soft play areas and mini-karts to dodgems, karting and formula 1 simulators, there's something for everyone. Then sit back with a snack in the chip shop or a nice pot of tea in Tiffany's tearoom. Don't forget to pick up an ice-cream as you leave.

### Funland

From June to September, there's a feast of rides and games at the Tropicana. Entry is free and rides are paid for by a token system.

### Donkey Rides

The friendly, gentle donkeys are on the beach from Easter to September in fair weather. For those who don't want to ride, there's a Fireman Sam engine or Thomas the Tank Engine, pulled by ponies.

### Sky View Wheel

Weston Wheel, located on the seafront, is here from Easter to September.

### **Pirate Adventureland**

Right next to the big wheel, you can walk the plank on the high ropes course, or play adventure golf, or just have a cup of tea while the rest of your family take all the risks.

**Dolphin Square** sits behind the Premier Inn and is home to Cineworld, Clip n Climb and All Stars Sports Bowl where you can either sit in comfort with your popcorn or strap yourself up for an hour's exhilaration of wall climbs of up to 10 metres in height.

### **Weston Museum**

Weston's museum is free to enter, with interactive displays and touring exhibitions. The light and airy Clara's Café serves freshly-ground coffee, delicious cakes and light lunches - definitely worth a visit. Located on Burlington Street, BS23 1PR

### **Independent Shops**

In the same area as the museum are Orchard Street and Meadow Street, known as Orchard Meadows. These and their side streets are packed with unusual, independent shops that you won't find on the High Street. Towards Grove Park is Grove Village with lots of independent shops and eateries and a village atmosphere.

### **Grove Park**

You'll find Grove Park close to Grove Village, there's a café, a fishpond, our War Memorial, the Mayor's Parlour and a memorial garden to Westonian broadcaster, Jill Dando. It's a lovely spot in which to relax after exploring the shops.

### **Marine Lake**

With a small, safe beach and a protected salt-water lake, this is the ideal place to swim without worrying about tides. It's at the north end of the beach near to the RNLI shop.

### **Water Adventure Play Park**

Loads of fun for children, going north from the Grand Pier, just across the road from the archway before Marine Lake. The adventure park is open all year round, the splash pads in high season only when there's a £3 charge per child. There's a lovely café and picnics are welcome.

### **A Walk Through Victorian Weston**

Follow in the footsteps of the architect Hans Fowler Price, who worked in Weston for over 50 years and left a significant legacy of buildings.

### **Street Art Trail**

At the same time, you might enjoy spotting the amazing street art by both local and international artists. There's a map for this too in the Visitor Centre.



### **Parks**

Why not take your picnic to one of Weston-super-Mare's many parks; Grove Park, Clarence Park and Ellenborough Park are all within walking distance.

### **Crazy Golf**

Walk north from the pier and you will find two courses for all the family to enjoy and a more challenging park at Pirate Adventureland

### **Hutton Moor Leisure Centre**

With indoor swimming, a skatepark, gym and fitness studios, a good way to loosen up or break a journey. BS22 8LY

### **The Helicopter Museum**

The world's largest helicopter collection is a short drive from the beachfront en route to the M5 on the A371. BS24 8PP

### **Puxton Park**

On the A370 half a mile across the M5 at Junction 21, fun for all the family. Don't miss their farm shop and café.
